If your child needs to contact you, they may come to Reception to do so.



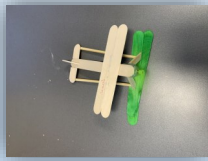
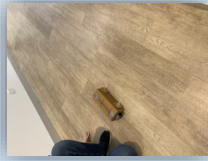
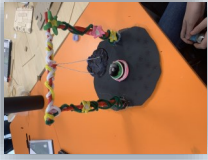
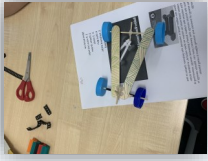

Camps and Excursions Program

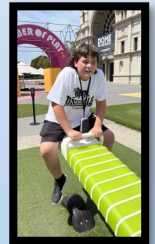
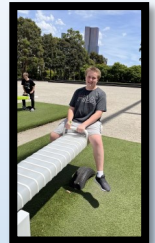
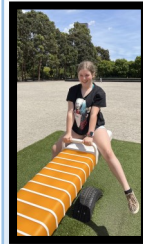
