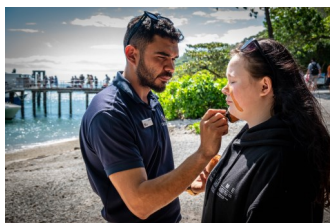

Appointments to see Sile can be made at the office.

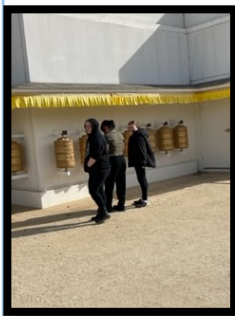
## MOBILE PHONE POLICY 2023

Students **MUST** hand their phones and/or other devices in before school and retrieve them at 3pm.



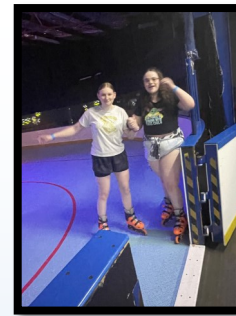

Hello strangers,

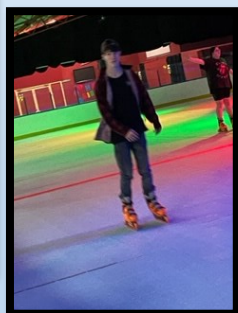

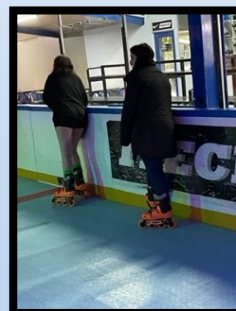

Talk Money with Ecstra Foundation will be visiting Shepparton ACE Secondary College soon.

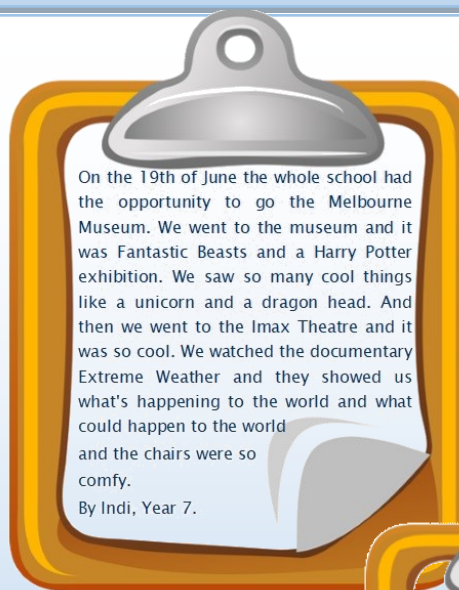
Talk Money is a free financial education program that teaches young Australians money lessons for life and aims to help students be confident when talking about money and to make informed financial decisions.

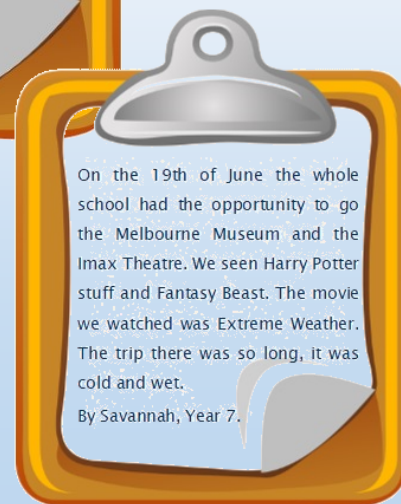
